

INSTRUCTOR TRAINING COURSE FOR AIR INSPECTORS	
Scope of training	This course will allow delegates to learn how to plan, conduct and manage audits in accredited organisations in accordance with EASA/SARI Parts and how to oversight these organisations
Objectives of the course	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revise the main principles and objectives of each EASA/SARI Part • Acquire auditing techniques and best practice to prepare, realise, follow-up audits about maintenance / training organisations • Acquire knowledge of Aircraft Maintenance Part-66 Licenses and about the training of personnel
Course duration	Theoretical session: 7 days Workshop: 5 days
Recommended participant profile	This course is recommended for Senior inspectors required to perform internal or external audits. Delegates should have a basic knowledge or reading of SARI parts, and should have a good knowledge and practice of audit techniques. Technical Knowledge is recommended about EWIS, Fuel Tank Safety (Phase 1) and non-destructive testing methods.
Key topics	<p><u>Theoretical session</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Day 1 to 4: EASA/SARI procedures / reminders about the regulation • Day 5-6: Presentation and study about Aircraft Maintenance Licences and training organisations (Part 66/147) with exercises and examples to consolidate acquired Knowledge • Day 7: Human Factors overview <p><u>Workshop</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Day 8: Training about the different audit phases through audit simulation. Real case presented at the beginning of the day. The trainees then conduct an audit simulation. The closing session of the audit allows the debriefing of the trainees. <p><u>OJT in a real maintenance organisation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Day 9: Prepare a real audit • Day 10: Conduct the on-site audit • Day 11: Write and follow-up the audit reports • Day 12: Debriefing, conclusion and reminder of good practices • Training about approval of a maintenance program
Method of delivery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PowerPoint presentation and videos • Practical exercises • Audit simulation • Play situations • Good practice examples • Tutoring during one field audit
